MINISTRY OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

1. Amendment in the Companies Act, 2013

The Central Government, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 467 of the Companies Act, 2013 (18 of 2013), made amendments to Schedule V of the Companies Act, 2013 vide notification dated 18.03.2021. The said amended deals with remuneration of managerial person/s or other director/s.
